AGRICULTURE TRAINING PROJECT



NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:



RESOLVED and that such funds shall be deducted from budget line CD8525.533525.CDY38 (Youth Programming).
