RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN
AMENDMENT TO THE POLICE BENEVOLENT
ASSOCIATION AGREEMENT FOR 2012-2014

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2012, by Permanent Resolution 12-91 and pursuant to New York State Civil Service Law Article 14 – Public Employees’ Fair Employment Act, City Council approve a Collective Bargaining Agreement (“CBA”) with the Police Benevolent Association (the “PBA”); and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and the PBA have requested that the CBA be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the PBA to amend the CBA to include the following:

Section 9, *Vacation*, is amended to add a new paragraph “E” as follows:

- E. The Chief of Police may, at his or her discretion, approve at the time of appointment of a lateral transfer from another New York police agency vacation time as provided above which is commensurate with such lateral transfer’s prior years of police service, experience, and compliance with Civil Service.

Section 12, *Personal Leave*, is amended to add a new sentence at the end as follows:

Personal leave will be credited to new hires pro-rata, *i.e.*, one day for each four months worked in the first year.

Section 22, *Salary*, is amended to add a new paragraph “B” and to designate the existing undesignated paragraph as paragraph “A,” as follows:

- B. The Chief of Police may, at his or her discretion, approve at the time of appointment of a lateral transfer from another New York police agency to start at any Grade, commensurate with such lateral transfer’s prior years of police service, experience, and compliance with Civil Service. This option shall only be available if funds are budgeted and a position is vacant for the appropriate Grade.
