AN RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE
MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT
WITH OPPORTUNITIES FOR BROOME AND
TO APPROVE THE USE OF UP TO \$100,000 IN
HOME-CHDO FUNDS FOR THE
REHABILITATION OF 46 GRISWOLD STREET

WHEREAS, Opportunities for Broome is a Community Housing Development Organization ("CHDO"); and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton allocates funds received from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") for projects to be completed by various CHDOs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to designate Opportunities for Broome as a CHDO to rehabilitate certain real property located at 46 Griswold Street (the "Premises"); and


WHEREAS, funds for this CHDO project are available in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 total, \$72,938.26 from budget line CE8689.533802.CEY37 (FY37 2011 CHDO), and \$27,061.74 from budget line CE8689.533802.CEY38 (FY38 2012 CHDO).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the City of Binghamton does hereby designate Opportunities for Broome as a CHDO to rehabilitate certain real property located at 46 Griswold Street; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Opportunities for Broome for HUD Home CHDO funds in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 total, \$72,938.26 from budget line CE8689.533802.CEY37 (FY37 2011 CHDO), and \$27,061.74 from budget line CE8689.533802.CEY38 (FY38 2012 CHDO).
