and


WHEREAS, the Notice of Claim Act requires municipalities to designate an official for
receipt of service of a notice of claim filed with the New York Secretary of State.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular
session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Council of the City of Binghamton hereby designates the Corporation
Counsel or the City Clerk as the officials for receipt of service of a notice of claim filed with the
New York Secretary of State; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Corporation Counsel shall determine which office and which
individual(s), if necessary, shall be listed with the New York Secretary of State for such receipt
of service.
