TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
SENTRY ALARMS FOR CENTRAL OFFICE
MONITORING SERVICES AT BINGHAMTON
FIRE DEPARTMENT FACILITIES AT 1
BELDEN STREET AND 2 JACKSON STREET,
BINGHAMTON, NEW YORK

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with Sentry Alarms for Central Office Monitoring Services at Binghamton Fire Department facilities located at 1 Belden Street and 2 Jackson Street; and

WHEREAS, Sentry Alarms agrees to provide 24-hour Central Office Monitoring Services at no cost to the City of Binghamton.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Sentry Alarms to provide Central Office Monitoring Services at Binghamton Fire Department facilities located at 1 Belden Street and 2 Jackson Street at no cost to the City and that the City hereby accepts this gift of services.
