WHEREAS, the Binghamton Mets Baseball Club, Inc. has contacted the City of Binghamton expressing a desire to erect a permanent picnic pavilion at NYSEG Stadium, located at 211 Henry Street, Binghamton, New York; and

WHEREAS, this structure will be separate from the current NYSEG stadium, and the construction will be funded entirely by the Binghamton Mets Baseball Club, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to accept the gift of a permanent picnic pavilion.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the City of Binghamton does hereby approve the acceptance of a permanent picnic pavilion at NYSEG Stadium from the Binghamton Mets Baseball Club, Inc., in accordance with the specifications determined by the Commission on Architecture and Urban Design, the Office of Building Construction, Zoning & Code Enforcement, and the New York State Department of Labor requirements for construction on a public facility.
