A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE
APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF A
2014 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE
ASSISTANCE GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible for a 2014 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Local Solicitation grant ("JAG Grant") in the amount of \$24,528 to be used for the establishment of additional police officer patrols in City parks; and

WHEREAS, the JAG Grant will require a Inter-Local Agreement with Broome County whereby the City will agree to be responsible for administration of the grant funds; and


WHEREAS, the JAG Grant does not require a local match; the grant funds will be administered by the Chief of Police or his designee; and the estimated date of completion will be September 30, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office Corporation Counsel, as may be necessary to accept a 2014 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Local Solicitation grant in the amount of \$24,528 and to enter into a Inter-Local Agreement with Broome County establishing the City of Binghamton as the grant administering municipality; and be it further

RESOLVED that there is no City match for the acceptance of such funds; that the Chief of Police shall be the grant project administrator, and that the estimated date of completion will be September 30, 2015.


