RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION UNDER THE 2014 NYS DOT TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM FUNDING CYCLE TO IMPLEMENT MULTI-MODEL IMPROVEMENTS AND STREETSCAPE ENHANCEMENTS ALONG THE STATE STREET AND HAWLEY STREET INTERSECTION

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is applying to the NYS DOT Transportation Alternatives Program in the amount of \$480,000 to implement multi-model improvements and streetscape enhancements along the State Street and Hawley Street intersection; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project is \$600,000, with \$120,000 in local match; the grant project manager will be the Commissioner of Public Works; and the anticipated date of project completion is Fall 2016; and

WHEREAS, 2015 bond financing will be requested to cover the local cost of the project; and

WHEREAS, 80% of approved project expenditures will be reimbursed by NYSDOT.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Council of the City of Binghamton does hereby approve and endorse the application of the city for a grant in the amount of \$480,000 under the NYS DOT Transportation Alternatives Program to implement multi-model improvements and streetscape enhancements along the State Street and Hawley Street intersection; and be it further

RESOLVED that the total cost of the project is \$600,000, with \$120,000 in local match; the grant project manager is the Commissioner of Public Works; and the anticipated date of project completion is Fall 2016; and be it further

RESOLVED that this Resolution approves the submission of the grant application and does not constitute approval to accept grant funds; and be it further

RESOLVED that the grant may only be accepted upon approval by City Council.
