WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is seeking grant monies under the New York Rising Communities Program; and

WHEREAS, Broome County is interested in acquiring a portion of the GSA Depot Site in Hillcrest for use as a regional emergency shelter during states of emergency; and

WHEREAS, a feasibility study for the conversion of the Depot site is necessary before such project can proceed; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is willing to contribute towards the preparation of a feasibility study for the conversion of the GSA Depot Site into a regional emergency shelter.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Broome County for the preparation of a feasibility study to convert the GSA Depot Site in Hillcrest into a regional emergency shelter; and be it further

RESOLVED that the City of Binghamton shall allocate to Broome County an amount not to exceed \$100,000 as its contribution towards the cost of the feasibility study, contingent upon the City of Binghamton receiving a grant for such funds under the New York Rising program.
