RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH MCFARLAND-JOHNSON TO PROVIDE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION FOR RIVERSIDE DRIVE / BEETHOVEN STREET INTERSECTION SIGNAL REPLACEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with McFarland-Johnson to provide design and construction inspection for Riverside Drive/Beethoven Street Intersection signal replacement; and

WHEREAS, this project is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, which calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ration of 80% Federal funds and 20% non-Federal funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible to receive 15% reimbursement of all costs associated with this project through Marchiselli funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the Federal and non-Federal share of the Project; and

WHEREAS, funding for design and construction inspection services is available from budget line H1650.525139.40914 (Signals/Combined Shops).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE, that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with McFarland-Johnson to provide design and construction inspection for Riverside Drive/Beethoven Street Intersection Signal Replacement; and be it further

RESOLVED that funding for design and construction inspection services shall be deducted from budget line H1650.525139.40914 (Signals/Combined Shops).
