WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton adopted Permanent Resolution 13-26 on February 20, 2013 entitled, "A Resolution Authorizing the Mayor to Enter into a Lease with the United Way of Broome County to Lease a Portion of the Lee Barta Community Center"; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to amend the lease to allow the United Way of Broome County to lease the basement of the Lee Barta Community Center to operate the Fresh Cycles program and to extend the term of the lease to December 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton wishes to authorize the Mayor to enter into an amended lease agreement with the United Way of Broome County for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documentation, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, to amend the lease agreement to lease the basement of the Lee Barta Community Center to the United Way to operate the Fresh Cycles program and to extend the term of the lease to December 31, 2015.
