WHEREAS, Stellar 6001 LLC, has contacted the City of Binghamton expressing a desire to provide labor and materials to install five walkway lights, two exit, one emergency light, and one security access pad in the City-owned transit ramp located between 83 Court Street and the State Street parking ramp; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to accept the gift of labor and materials with a retail value of \$2,650 from Stellar 6001 LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the City of Binghamton does hereby approve the acceptance of labor and materials to install five walkway lights, two exit, one emergency light, and one security access pad in the City-owned transit ramp located between 83 Court Street and the State Street parking ramp; and be it further

RESOLVED that Stellar 6001 LLC will pay its employees performing the installation a "prevailing wage" are required by the New York State Department of Labor.
