**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR  
TO AMEND FY40 ESG CONTRACT WITH  
FAMILY ENRICHMENT NETWORK, INC**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Resolution R15-25, entitled, "A Resolution Authorizing the Mayor to Enter into an Agreement with Family Enrichment Network for the Use of FY40 ESG Funding in an Amount Not to Exceed \$47,000.25," the City entered into a FY40 ESG Contract with the Family Enrichment Network; and

WHEREAS, the Family Enrichment Network wishes to amend the FY40 ESG Contract to decrease funding for the Case Manager from \$8,799 to \$0 and to increase funding for the Director of Housing and Services from \$2,000 to \$10,799 due to a merger of positions; and

WHEREAS, no additional funding is required for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Family Enrichment Network to amend the FY40 ESG Contract to decrease funding for the Case Manager from \$8,799 to \$0 and to increase funding for the Director of Housing and Services from \$2,000 to \$10,799 due to a merger of positions and that no additional funding is required for this amendment.
