A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE JOINT
SEWAGE BOARD TO ACCEPT A NYS
OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY & HEALTH
HAZARD ABATEMENT BOARD GRANT FOR
THE 2015-2016 PROGRAM YEAR IN AN
AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$18,131

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton (the "City") is a joint owner of the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Treatment Facilities (the "JSTF") with the Village of Johnson City (the "Village"); and

WHEREAS, the JSTF are operated and maintained by the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board (the "Sewage Board") under a series of inter-municipal agreements (collectively the "IMA") between the City and the Village; and

WHEREAS, the IMA reserves unto the City and Village the power to "accept gifts, grants and bequests"; and

WHEREAS, the Sewage Board has received an initial award letter for a 2015-2016 New York State Occupational Safety and Health Hazard Abatement Board safety and training project grant ("HAB Grant") in an amount not to exceed \$18,131, to be used for implementation of workplace safety and health training programs at the JSTF; and

WHEREAS, the HAB Grant is awarded on a "reimbursement-only" basis and does not require a local match, the grant funds will be administered by the Laboratory Director & Safety Manager, and the estimated date of completion of the training program is September 1, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE, that the Sewage Board may accept on behalf of the City of Binghamton and Village of Johnson City, as co-owners of the JSTF, a 2015-2016 HAB Grant in an amount not to exceed \$18,131 for workplace safety and health training programs, and the Sewage Board's Fiscal Officer is authorized to amend the JSTF budget to provide for said revenues and training expenses as necessary and the Sewage Board is hereby authorized to execute any and all contracts and documents as may be necessary to qualify for and receive such reimbursement grant proceeds; and be it further
