RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH NYS DOT ALLOWING THE STATE TO PERFORM WORK ON CITY SANITATION LINES ON NYS 17/I-81 AS PART OF THE NYS 17/I-81 INTERCHANGE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AND FOR THE CITY TO MAINTAIN THE SANITATION LINES UPON COMPLETION OF PROJECT

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Transportation ("NYSDOT") proposes the construction, reconstruction, or improvement of "NYS 17/I-81 Interchange Reconstruction-Phase 2 (Reconstruction of NYS 17 and I-81 in the City of Binghamton including the Replacement of 4 Bridges and Construction of 2 Bridges and a partial Cloverleaf Interchange)" in the City of Binghamton located in Broome County, PIN 9500.80; and

WHEREAS, the State will include as part of the construction, reconstruction, or improvement of the above mentioned project the relocation and adjustment to sanitation lines and appurtenances, pursuant to Section 10, Subdivision 24, of the State Highway Law, as shown on the contract plans relating to the project and meeting the requirements of the owner; and

WHEREAS, the service life of the relocated and or replaced utilities has not been extended; and

WHEREAS, the State will provide for the reconstruction of the above mentioned work, as shown on the contract plans relating to the above mentioned project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the City of Binghamton approves of the relocation of and adjustment to their sanitation lines and appurtenances and the above mentioned work performed on the project and shown on the contract plans relating to the project and that the City of Binghamton will maintain or cause to be maintained the adjusted facilities performed as above stated and as shown on the contract plans; and be it further

RESOLVED that the City of Binghamton Mayor has the authority to sign, with the concurrence of the City Council, any and all documentation that may become necessary as a result of this project as it relates to the City of Binghamton; and be it further

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RESOLVED that the Clerk of the City of Binghamton is hereby directed to transmit five (5) certified copies of the foregoing resolution to the New York State Department of Transportation.
