
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Action for Older Persons for the use of Fiscal Year 40 Community Development Block Grant funds in the total amount of \$19,998.00 and that funds shall be deducted from budget line CD8676.533515.CDY40 (Human Services).
