WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with Family Enrichment Network for the use of Fiscal Year 40 Emergency Shelter Grant funding in the total amount of \$47,000.25.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Family Enrichment Network for the use of Fiscal Year 40 Emergency Shelter Grant funds in the total amount of \$47,000.25 and that funds shall be deducted from budget line CD6142.533550.CDY40 (ESG – Program Funds).
