WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with the Volunteers of America for the use of Fiscal Year 40 Emergency Shelter Grants funding in an amount not to exceed \$11,712.25.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with the YWCA of Binghamton/Broome County for the use of Fiscal Year 40 Emergency Shelter Grants funding in an amount not to exceed \$11,712.25 and that funds shall be deducted from budget line CD6142.533550.CDY40 (ESG – Program Funds).
