A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING
SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 3 WITH
NYSDOT FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL UPGRADE
AT RIVERSIDE DRIVE AND BEETHOVEN
STREET

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2009 the Council of the City of Binghamton adopted Permanent Resolution 09-65, entitled "A Resolution Authorizing the Mayor to Enter into an Agreement with NYSDOT for Traffic Signal Upgrade at Intersection of Beethoven Street and Riverside Drive, PIN 9753.60", and

WHEREAS, on February 23, 2011 the Council of the City of Binghamton adopted Permanent Resolution 11-10, entitled "A Resolution Authorizing the Mayor to Enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with NYSDOT on Riverside Drive/Beethoven Street Traffic Signal Upgrade Project, PIN 9753.60; and

WHEREAS, on October 22, 2014 the Council of the City of Binghamton adopted Permanent Resolution 14-66, entitled "A Resolution Authorizing the Mayor to Enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 2 with NYSDOT on Riverside Drive/Beethoven Street Traffic Signal Upgrade Project, PIN 9753.60; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works has recommended entering into Supplemental Agreement No. 3 with NYSDOT for construction inspection and additional design work in an amount not to exceed \$235,000; and

WHEREAS, this project is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, which calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ration of 80% Federal funds and 20% non-Federal funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible to receive 15% reimbursement of all costs associated with this project through Marchiselli funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the Federal and non-Federal share of the Project; and

WHEREAS, funding for construction inspection and additional design work is available from budget line H1650.525139.40914 (Traffic Signal Riverside/Beethoven).

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

RESOLVE, that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 3, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with NYSDOT to provide construction inspection and additional design work on the Riverside Drive/Beethoven Street signal upgrade project (PIN 9753.60); and be it further

RESOLVED that funding for construction inspection and additional design work is available from budget line H1650.525139.40914 (Traffic Signal Riverside/Beethoven).
