A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE  
ACCEPTANCE OF \$100,000 FROM THE  
DEPARTMENT OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE  
SERVICES LEGISLATIVE GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible for the Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) Legislative Grant in the amount of \$100,000 to be used for police dashcams, to partially fund a firearms simulator system, and an upgrade to the Livescan fingerprint system; and

WHEREAS, the DCJS Legislative Grant does not require a local match, that the grant will be administered by the Chief of Police or his designee, and that the estimated date of completion is September 30, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, as may be necessary to accept the DCJS Legislative Grant in the amount of \$100,000; and be it further

RESOLVED that there is no required City match for the acceptance of such funds, that the grant will be administered by the Chief of Police or his designee, and that the estimated date of completion is September 30, 2016.
