WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with Stafkings Personnel Systems for a Project Assistant regarding the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Treatment Facility for a term ending on December 31, 2016, at a cost not to exceed \$45,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Stafkings Personnel Systems for a Project Assistant regarding the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Treatment Facility for a term ending on December 31, 2016, at a cost not to exceed \$45,000 and that funding for such services be deducted from budget line G8150.54410 (Professional Services).
