A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO AN AMENDED AGREEMENT
WITH MCFARLAND JOHNSON FOR DESIGN
SERVICES ON THE STATE STREET
PEDESTRIAN/STREET SCAPE
IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, PIN 9009.36

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Resolution R15-118 dated November 18, 2015, the City of Binghamton entered into an agreement with McFarland Johnson to provide design services for the State Street Pedestrian/Street Scape Improvements project (PIN 9009.36) at a cost not to exceed \$138,843; and

WHEREAS, due to a change in the scope of services, the cost has been reduced to \$133,449; and


WHEREAS, this project is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, which calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% Federal funds and 20% non-Federal funds; and

WHEREAS, funds for such agreement are available from budget line H5110.525163.21815 (Construction of State St.) pending reimbursement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to enter into an amended agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with McFarland Johnson to provide design services for the State Street Pedestrian/Street Scape Improvements project (PIN 9009.36) at a cost not to exceed \$133,449 and that funding for such agreement shall be deducted from budget line H5110.525163.21815 (Construction of State St.) pending reimbursement.


