RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE NYSDOT FOR CONSTRUCTION AND CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE FRONT STREET PAVEMENT RESTORATION PROJECT, PIN 9753.86

WHEREAS, a project for the Front Street Pavement Restoration, P.I.N. 9753.86 (the "Project"), is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% Federal funds and 20% non-Federal funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton previously approved a contract with the New York State Department of Transportation ("NYSDOT") for preliminary engineering work and wishes to enter into a supplemental agreement for construction and construction inspection services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the Federal and non-Federal share of the construction and construction inspection services at a cost of \$214,000 which is available from budget line H5120.525137.40914 (Front St. Pavement Restoration).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Council of the City of Binghamton hereby approves the above-subject Project; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Binghamton hereby authorizes the City of Binghamton to pay in the first instance 100% of the Federal and non-Federal share of the costs of the construction and construction inspection services for the Project or portions thereof; and be it further

RESOLVED that the sum of \$214,000 is hereby appropriated from budget line H5120.525137.40914 (Front St. Pavement Restoration) and made available to cover the cost of participation in the above phase of the Project; and be it further

RESOLVED that in the event the full Federal and non-Federal share costs of the project exceeds the amount appropriated above, the Council of the City of Binghamton shall convene as

soon as possible to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon the notification by the NYSDOT thereof; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton be and is hereby authorized to execute all necessary Agreements, certifications or reimbursement requests for Federal-aid and/or Marchiselli-aid on behalf of the City of Binghamton with the NYSDOT in connection with the advancement or approval of the Project and providing for the administration of the Project and the Municipality's first instance funding of projects costs and permanent funding of the local share of Federal-aid and State-aid eligible Project costs and all Project costs within appropriation therefore that are not so eligible; and be it further

RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be filed with the New York State Commissioner of Transportation by attaching it to any necessary Agreement in connection with the Project; and be it further

RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
