A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR A SCATTER SITE PUMP STATION UPGRADE PROJECT TO BE UNDERTAKEN BY THE DORMITORY AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF NYEW YORK (DASNY) ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF BINGHAMTON USING NY RISING COMMUNITY RECONSTRUCTION PROGRAM (NYRCR) COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT DISASTER RECOVERY (CDBG-DR) FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to utilize the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York (DASNY) to undertake a Scatter Site Pump Station Upgrade project using a portion of its allotment of NY Rising Community Reconstruction Program (NYRCR) Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds; and

WHEREAS, the project includes design, construction and construction inspection services for up to four (4) pump stations, contingent upon available funding, including Rush Avenue Stormwater Pump Station, Glenwood Avenue Stormwater Pump Station, Bevier Street Sanitary Sewer Pump Station and Jackson Street Stormwater Pump station; and

WHEREAS, DASNY will serve as Subrecipient of CDBG-DR funds for said project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton, will serve as Project Sponsor of the Application to be submitted by DASNY to the Governor's Office of Storm Recovery (GOSR).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized as Project Sponsor to sign any and all documents required for the project, including the Project Application and Project Agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, and as required by GOSR and/or the New York State Housing Trust Fund Corporation (HTFC) for the implementation of the Scatter Site Pump Station Upgrade Project.
