WHEREAS, the City Engineer recommends the City enter into a Professional Services agreement with Barton & Loguidice, DPC for preliminary engineering and design services for the Pedestrian Safety Improvements Project, PIN 9754.63; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for such services is \$77,800; and

WHEREAS, the City will be reimbursed 100% with Federal funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a Professional Services agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Barton & Loguidice, DPC for preliminary engineering and design services for the Pedestrian Safety Improvements Project, PIN 9754.63, at a cost of \$77,800, of which 100% is Federally funded, and that pending reimbursement funds shall be deducted from budget line H5110.525321.20619 (Pedestrian Improvements).
