A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO A TERM AGREEMENT FOR
2020 WITH KEYSTONE ENVIRONMENTAL
SERVICES FOR THE 2020 CALENDAR YEAR

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into a term agreement for 2020 with Keystone Environmental Services for environmental services on an as-needed basis at a total cost not to exceed \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, the rate for each service to be provided is set forth in the attached fee schedule; and

WHEREAS, a requisition for a purchase order must be submitted for requested work and the City of Binghamton Engineering Department will be notified prior to any work conducted; and

WHEREAS, funding for such services must be drawn from applicable budget lines in the 2020 budget and approved by the Board of Contract and Supply and the Comptroller; and

WHEREAS, this term agreement may be renewed for up to two additional years, provided the rates stay the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Keystone Environmental Services for environmental services on an as-needed basis for various projects at a total cost not to exceed \$50,000, a requisition for a purchase order must be submitted for requested work, the Department of Engineering is to be notified prior to any work, funds will be deducted from the associated budget line for the various projects as approved by the Board of Contract and Supply and the Comptroller, and this term agreement may be renewed for up to two additional years, provided the rates stay the same.
