
WHEREAS, the City Engineer recommends the City enter into a Professional Services agreement with Barton & Loguidice, DPC for preliminary design services for the DECO District Streetscape Improvements project; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost for such services is not to exceed \$174,970.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a Professional Services agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Barton & Loguidice, DPC for the preliminary design services for the DECO District Streetscape Improvements project at a cost not to exceed \$174,970, and funds shall be deducted from budget line H5110.555555.M0015 (DECO District Grant), for this purpose.
