WHEREAS, the State of New York Department of Transportation proposes to relocate sanitation lines, water lines, appurtenance, plate reader, and street lights with the project located in County of Broome and within the geographical jurisdiction of the MUNICIPALITY (City of Binghamton) for the Greenway Project, PIN 903826; and

WHEREAS, the project is at no cost to the City of Binghamton; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton approves of such project and desires to have a maintenance plan for the project within its geographical jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton will maintain these items upon the completion of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the City of Binghamton does approve the above subject project; and it is further

RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Binghamton hereby authorizes the Mayor of the City of Binghamton to enter into agreement with the State of New York and through the Commissioner of Transportation to relocate sanitation lines, water lines, appurtenance, plate reader, and street lights at no cost to the City of Binghamton; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the City of Binghamton will maintain these items upon the completion of the project; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of this City of Binghamton is hereby directed to transmit five (5) certified copies of the foregoing resolution to the State Department of Transportation, 44 Hawley Street, Binghamton, New York 13901-3200, Attention Regional Utility Engineer.
