WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Resolution 18-46, dated May 9, 2018, the City of Binghamton entered into a professional services agreement with Barton & Loguidice, DPC for construction review services for the State Street Pedestrian/Streetscape Improvements, PIN 9009.36, and State-Hawley Street signal upgrade, PIN 9754.08; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended a contract extension at no cost to the City of Binghamton from May 25, 2020, to June 30, 2020; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a no cost time extension, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Barton & Loguidice, DPC from May 25, 2020, to June 30, 2020, for construction inspection services on the State Street Pedestrian/Streetscape Improvements, PIN 9009.36 and State Street Traffic Signal Upgrade, PIN 9754.08.
