AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO SUBMIT THE FISCAL YEAR 40 ANNUAL
ACTION PLAN AND TO ACCEPT ANY AND
ALL FUNDS ALLOCATED BY THE U.S.
DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN
DEVELOPMENT FROM THE CDBG, ESG AND
HOME ENTITLEMENT PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton receives funding through the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) under the Community Development Block Grant, HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME) and the Emergency Shelter Grants (ESG) Programs and Home Entitlement Programs; and

WHEREAS, the application on behalf of the City of Binghamton to HUD for the Fiscal Year 40 Entitlement is due to be submitted to HUD forty-five (45) days prior to the City's fiscal year, but not later than HUD's statutory deadline of August 14, 2014, covering the period of September 1, 2014, through August 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to submit the Fiscal Year 40 Annual Action Plan to HUD and to accept any and all funds that are awarded.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to submit the Fiscal Year 40 Annual Action Plan in accordance with the budget approved by the City and to accept any and all funds that are awarded by the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME) and Emergency Shelter Grants (ESG) Programs and Home Entitlement Programs.
