**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO AMEND FY41 HOME PROGRAM INCOME
AND FY41 HOME REHAB BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the Director of Planning, Housing, & Community Development and the Grants Administrator find it proper and necessary to amend the Community Development Block Grant (“CDBG”) Fiscal Year 41 (FY41) budget to increase revenue budget line CE42170L (Program Income-Loans) and expense budget line CE8668.533800 (Rehab-Program Income Funds) both in the amount of \$200,000, for rehabilitation of private homes in the City; and

WHEREAS, the above revenue is available from previously unallocated program income from loans; and

WHEREAS, these are substantial amendments to said CDBG budgets, the City has provided a 30 day public comment period, and a public hearing was held on October 21, 2015; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Grant Administrator of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the CDBG FY41 budget to increase revenue budget line CE42170L (Program Income-Loans) and expense budget line CE8668.533800 (Rehab-Program Income Funds) both in the amount of \$200,000, for rehabilitation of private homes in the City.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
