



PROPOSED LEGISLATION WORDING

ORDINANCE

entitled

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE 2013 BUDGET OF THE BINGHAMTON-JOHNSON CITY JOINT SEWAGE BOARD AND APPROVING A TRANSFER THEREIN WITHOUT INCREASING TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Johnson City approve the annual budget of the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board (“JSB”); and

WHEREAS, the JSB has requested a modification in the 2013 Joint Sewage Board Operating Budget, together with a corresponding budget transfer, in order to correct a condition of inverted compensation and thereby pay a base salary commensurate with the management and supervisory duties of the presently vacant the Laboratory Director/Safety Manager position, with the intention to fill the vacant position by promoting from within an employee who recently passed the Civil Service examination for the position; and

WHEREAS, the JSB has requested this budget modification so that the base salary of the Laboratory Director/Safety Manager will reflect and adequately compensate the incumbent for the responsibilities shouldered and vital services rendered in relation to daily operations of the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Treatment Facilities (“JSTF”), including duties pertaining to upcoming multi-million dollar demolition, rehabilitation, and construction projects that will be ongoing for the next several years at the JSTF, as well as so that the salary will be greater than the base earnings plus overtime compensation earned by the subordinates working directly under the supervision of the Laboratory Director/Safety Manager; and

WHEREAS, it is essential that the JSB fill the vacant Laboratory Director/Safety Manager position as soon as possible in order to comply with regulations of the New York State Department of Health which require the appointment, by name, of a Laboratory Director in order for the JSTF Laboratory to retain its accreditation,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular

session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. The City of Binghamton hereby authorizes and directs the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board Fiscal Officer to transfer \$5,092 from 2013 Joint Sewage Board Operating Budget Line J8130.51699 (“Wage/Salary Adjustment/Stipends”) to 2013 Joint Sewage Board Operating Budget Line J8130.51000 (“Personnel Services”).

Section 2. The City of Binghamton hereby approves a modification to the unnumbered sub-line in the Personal Services section of the 2013 Joint Sewage Board Operating Budget for the title Laboratory Director/Safety Manager to increase the annual base salary from “up to \$48,960” to “up to \$55,302”.

Section 3. Upon making the above transfer and modification, the incumbent in the Laboratory Director/Safety Manager position shall not be eligible for any salary adjustment Stipend compensation during the remainder of 2013.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval by a majority of the Council of the City of Binghamton and a majority of the Board of Trustees of the Village.

I HEREBY CERTIFY that the above-described funds are unencumbered and available.



Enclosed for processing are five copies of Supplemental Agreement #2 to Federal-Aid/Marchiselli-Aid Project Agreement (D017713) to perform the Preliminary Engineering and Right-of-Way Incidentals work. The work involves traffic signal upgrades at the intersection of US Route 11 (Front Street) and Clinton Street and lowering the pavement elevation under the adjacent Norfolk Southern Railroad overpass bridges over US Route 11 (Front Street) in the City of Binghamton, Broome County. This is a Locally Administered Project.

All five copies must have original signatures and all copies must be notarized. In addition, five certified copies of the necessary Resolution must accompany the Agreements (a sample resolution is included in the agreement). Please return all five copies to our Regional Office for further processing. A completed copy will be returned to you once the agreement has been fully executed.

The estimated cost for the Preliminary Engineering work has increased to \$395,000. The City will be reimbursed 80% of \$305,000, or \$244,000, with Federal funds. The City will also be reimbursed 15%, or \$45,750, of this \$305,000 cost through the State Marchiselli Program. The remaining \$90,000 (\$395,000-\$305,000) will be reimbursed 100% with Federal funds. Therefore, the necessary City Resolution must authorize an additional \$90,000 for this phase of the project.
