

WHEREAS, the Police Chief and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2016 Police Bureau budget to eliminate one Senior Typist position at a salary of up to \$24,943 and to add a Senior Clerk position at an annual salary of up to \$24,943 (the actual salary may be less), effective September 24, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Water and Sewer Superintendent and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2016 Sewer Budget to eliminate the Sewer Bureau Chief position at an annual salary of \$54,184 and to add a Sanitary Sewer System Supervisor position at an annual salary of \$49,796 effective September 24, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary Sewer System Supervisor position was approved by the Civil Service Commission on August 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, this change in position will create \$1,181 savings for the remainder of the year to be transferred to contingency; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on September 21, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1.
