**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING
FROM EMPIRE STATE DEVELOPMENT
CORPORATION RESTORE NEW YORK
COMMUNITIES INITIATIVE ROUND IV**

WHEREAS, the Restore New York Communities Initiative provides municipalities with financial assistance for revitalization of commercial and residential properties. The program encourages community development and neighborhood growth through the elimination and redevelopment of blighted structures; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible to apply for such funding in Round IV for up to \$1,000,000; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has determined that such funding should be used to assist with the demolition of buildings and structures at property located at 435 State Street. The proposed project on this site is consistent with the City's goals and plans, the financing proposed for the project is appropriate, and the project facilitates effective and efficient use of existing and future public resources so as to promote both economic development and preservation of community resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to sign and submit the Restore New York Round IV program application for up to \$1,000,000.
