ORDINANCE

entitled

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE POLICE BUREAU TO ACCEPT A DONATION OF A K-9 AND \$65,604.79 TO PURCHASE AND EQUIP A K-9 VEHICLE AND TO AMEND THE 2016 BUDGET ACORDINGLY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Ordinance 15-086 adopted on December 9, 2015, Thomas Tull offered to donate a K-9 and a fully equipped K-9 vehicle to the City of Binghamton Police Bureau; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Tull selected a vehicle from a local vendor, Matthews Auto, to be fully equipped; and

WHEREAS, the process to fully equip the K-9 vehicle is more complicated than Mr. Tull anticipated and he now wishes to donate \$65,604.79, representing the cost to purchase and fully equip the selected K-9 vehicle, to the Binghamton Police Bureau; and

WHEREAS, the Binghamton Police Bureau has use of a K-9 and fully equipped K-9 vehicle and has recommended acceptance of the donation.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the City accepts donation of a K-9 and \$65,604.79 from Thomas Tull to purchase a K-9 vehicle from Matthews Auto and to fully equip said vehicle for the Binghamton Police Bureau.

Section 2. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2016 budget to increase revenue budget line A42705 (Gifts and Donations) and expense line A3120.52100 (Vehicles) in the amount of \$65,604.79.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.


