AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2016  
BUDGET TO FUND DEMOLITION OF THE OLD  
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS BUILDING  
WITH FUNDS SAVED FROM THE LED LIGHT  
INSTALLATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2016 Budget to fund the demolition of the Old Department of Public Works building located on the corner of Brandywine and Robinson St. with funds saved from the LED light installation project transferring \$120,000 from A5182.54202 (Electricity St. Lights) to A1364.54470 (Demolition); and


WHEREAS, such budget amendment was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on April 27, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2016 Budget to transfer \$120,000 from A5182.54202 (Electricity St. Lights) to A1364.54470 (Demolition) to fund demolition of the Old Department of Public Works building located on the corner of Brandywine and Robinson St.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
