AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2016 BUDGET TO INCREASE THE INSURANCE RECOVERIES REVENUE LINE AND INCREASE THE VEHICLE PARTS EXPENSE LINE TO ACCOUNT FOR DAMAGES TO POLICE CARS FOR WHICH THE CITY OF BINGHAMTON RECEIVED INSURANCE FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2016 budget to increase revenue budget line A42680 (Insurance Recoveries) and increase expense budget line A3120.54450 (Vehicle Parts), each in the amount of \$10,170.65; and

WHEREAS, the increase of the revenue and expense lines is to account for damages to police cars for which the City of Binghamton received insurance funds; and


WHEREAS, such budget amendment was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on June 8, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2016 budget to increase revenue budget line A42680 (Insurance Recoveries) and increase expense budget line A3120.54450 (Vehicle Repair), each in the amount of \$10,170.65.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
