WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2016 budget to increase revenue budget line A41589 (Public Safety Dept Rev) and increase expense budget line A3120.54433 (In House Training Service), each in the amount of \$650; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton Police Bureau held diversity training and the Johnson City Police Department participated and contributed \$650 for said diversity training; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is adding the Johnson City Police Department's contribution to the appropriate City budget lines; and


WHEREAS, such budget amendment was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on June 8, 2016.

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2016 budget to increase revenue budget line A41589 (Public Safety Dept Rev) and increase expense budget line A3120.54433 (In House Training Service), each in the amount of \$650.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
