ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2016
BUDGET TO ACCOUNT FOR AN INSURANCE
RECOVERY AND TO REPLACE A DAMAGED
POLICE VEHICLE

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and Comptroller of the of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2016 budget to account for an insurance recovery from an automobile accident involving a police vehicle and to transfer funds to replace the damaged police vehicle; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on September 7, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2016 budget to account for an insurance recovery and to transfer funds to replace the damaged police vehicle as follows:
