**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO A SUPPLEMEENTAL
AGREEMENT WITH TIMHAAHS ASSOCIATES
FOR INSPECTION SERVICES OF CITY OWNED
PARKING RAMPS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Resolution R14-022 dated April 9, 2014, the City entered into an agreement with TimHaahs Associates for inspections services of City owned parking ramps; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended a supplemental agreement at a cost of \$30,575 to provide for more inspection site visits of City own parking ramps at State Street and Water Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a supplemental agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with TimHaahs Associates to provide for more inspection site visits of City own parking ramps at State Street and Water Street at a cost of \$30,575 and that funding for such services must be deducted from budget line H5650.525080.21815 (Parking Ramps).
