**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO A SUPPLEMENTAL
AGREEMENT NO. 2 WITH TIMHAAHS
ASSOCIATES FOR ADDITIONAL
RESTORATION DESIGN SERVICES FOR CITY
OWNED PARKING RAMPS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Resolution R14-022 dated April 9, 2014, the City entered into an agreement with TimHaahs Associates to provide restoration design services for City owned parking ramps; and

WHEREAS, the City is reviewing Supplemental Agreement No. 1, as Introductory Resolution R16-016, considered on this date, for additional inspection services; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended Supplemental Agreement No. 2 to provide additional restoration design services for City owned parking ramps at State Street and Water Street at a cost not to exceed \$70,850.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 2, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with TimHaahs Associates to provide additional restoration design services for City owned parking ramps at State Street and Water Street at a cost not to exceed \$70,850 and that funding for such services shall be deducted from budget line H5650.525080.21815 (Parking Garage Repairs).
