A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE \$210,104 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NYS DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES GUN INVOLVED VIOLENCE ELIMINATION INITIATIVE (GIVE) TO FUND THE SALARY AND BENEFITS FOR A ONE CRIME ANALYST POSITION AND ONE FIELD INTELLIGENCE OFFICER POSITION

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible to receive a \$210,104 grant from the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services Gun Involved Violence Elimination Initiative (GIVE) to fund a portion of the salary and benefits for one (1) Crime Analyst position and one (1) Field Intelligence Officer position, along with providing funds for travel and training for GIVE sponsored events, undercover expenses and to maintain closed-circuit cameras; and

WHEREAS, there is no required City match; that, pending reimbursement, funding for the project shall be drawn from the general fund; that the head of Crime Prevention in the Binghamton Police Department will be the grant project manager; and that the anticipated date of project completion is June 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to accept said grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Council of the City of Binghamton does hereby accept a grant from the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services Gun Involved Violence Elimination Initiative (GIVE) in an amount not to exceed \$210,104 to fund a portion of the salary and benefits for one (1) Crime Analyst position and one (1) Field Intelligence Officer position, along with providing funds for travel and training for GIVE sponsored events, undercover expenses and to maintain closed-circuit cameras; and be it further

RESOLVED that there is no required City match; that, pending reimbursement, funding for the project shall be drawn from the general fund; that the head of Crime Prevention in the Binghamton Police Department will be the grant project manager; and that the anticipated date of project completion is June 30, 2017; and be it further


