A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR  
TO ACCEPT \$5,000 FROM NYSERDA'S  
CLEANER GREENER COMMUNITIES  
INCENTIVE PROGRAM FOR ADOPTING  
STREAMLINED PERMITTING AND ZONING  
ORDINANCES FOR ELECTRIC VEHICLE  
CHARGING STATIONS

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton adopted Permanent Ordinance 16-11, dated February 3, 2016, titled "An Ordinance Amending Chapter 410, Zoning, of the Code of the City of Binghamton, to Incorporate Definitions and Regulations for Electric Vehicle Charging Stations"; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible to receive the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA) Cleaner Greener Communities incentive for \$5,000 for adopting a streamlined permitting and zoning ordinance for electric vehicle charging stations; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to accept said incentive.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Council of the City of Binghamton does hereby accept the NYSERDA Cleaner Greener Communities incentive for \$5,000 for adopting a streamlined permitting and zoning ordinance for electric vehicle charging stations; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into and execute an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with the NYSERDA to accept such incentive.


